Job Title: Low Vision Rehabilitation Specialist (LVRS)

Job Summary

The San Diego Center for the Blind (SDCB) is the only community-based vision rehabilitation program of its kind in San Diego County. Since 1972 SDCB has been providing services to adults with vision loss with the mission to assist in their adjustment to vision and help them return to living as independently as possible.

The LVRS will provide a functional vision evaluations utilizing instruments and techniques to assess visual acuity, visual fields, contrast sensitivity function, visual perceptual and visual motor functioning, literacy skills in reading and writing. as they relate to vision impairment and disability. The LVRS will also evaluate work history, educational performance, use of technology, quality of life and aspects of psychosocial and cognitive function. The LVRS will provide training on the use of a wide range of assistive devices.

The LVRS will work closely with the Low Vision OD and administrative assistant, staff of the Vision Rehabilitation program and staff of the Technology Center/Store to meet the needs of the consumer.
